FY2024 New Castle County Budget

- 5% tax credit to New Castle County homeowners. The County has increased its tax reserves by 400% over the past six years.
- \$138,965,000 is expected from real property taxes. Part of the reserves (\$15 million) will defray costs of the County-wide reassessment.
- The approved budget is \$331,422,408 budget (4% increase). The capital budget totals \$75,098,163, including general and sewer fund projects; rest will cover operating expenses.
- Spending for community development and housing assistance increases 50% which includes Section 8 waivers and rollout of the Lead Hazard Reduction Program, which will provide lead remediation to housing units, prioritizing households with children.
- Wilmington's Hope Center's operations budget is \$5 million (~2000 clients).
- Both police and emergency medical services will see 5% and 10% increases respectively, to fill vacancies within each division.
- \$2.7 Million will go toward new equipment for police and EMS workers, and new paramedic stations.
- The parks budget for ~250 parks (\$8 million capital budget) will include 25 new pickleball courts, a second turf field at Banning Park, upgrades to walking paths and softball fields at Delcastle Recreational Park and a new indoor track facility.
